Connection of Voyage Data Recorder (VDR, "Black Box") to the Smoke Detection System SDS-48

<u>General</u>

According to SOLAS Chapter V regulation 20 (Amendments 2000), all cargo ships over 3,000 gt built after July 1, 2002 the **fire alarm signal** and the fault **signal for loss of power supply** of the smoke detection system for cargo holds must be connected to a voyage data recorder (VDR).
